For two years, she had focused on painting the historical Route 9, from Wilmington to Dover, resulting in one of the largest bodies of artwork ever to record Delaware. Michele's work is also in the collection of Vice President Biden and Delaware's Governor Markel.

Michele continues to enhance her reputation for painting some of the more remote areas of our State. Her loose and generous handling of pigment enhances the feel of filtering light.
